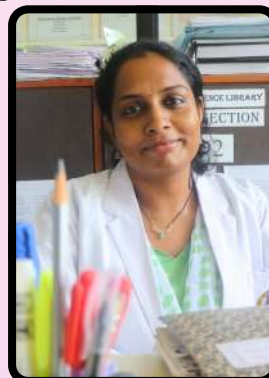

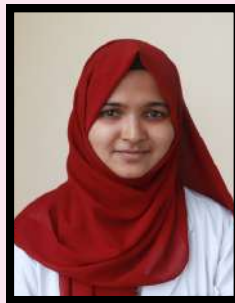

SPREADING HEALTH & HOPE.”**



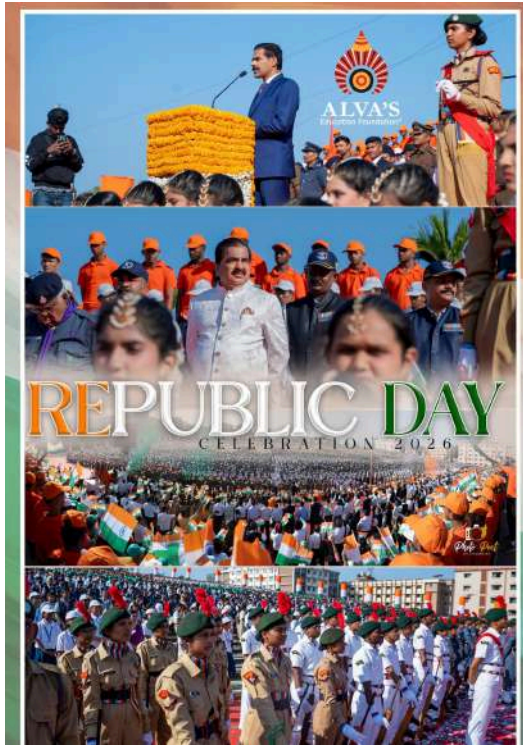
The Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology conducted a series of ten Female Health Camps and Awareness Programs across Dakshina Kannada from 15th December 2025 to 1st January 2026 at Somanadheshwara Temple, Iruvail Anganwadi, Poovanibettu Anganwadi, Pakshikara, Kodiyadukka, Guddeangadi Old-age Home, Gundeer Tribal Colony (Mijar), Huddgo Colony, and Alankar Old-age Home, screening a total of 166 women. The camps provided general health check-ups, vital assessments, BMI and nutritional evaluation, breast examinations, and cancer awareness sessions. Conducted by a team of doctors with the support of III BHMS students and interns, the initiative identified common health concerns such as osteoporosis, osteoarthritis, hypertension, diabetes, anaemia, PCOD, menstrual irregularities, urinary tract infections, and post-menopausal issues, while also promoting preventive care, diet management, and awareness for long-term women’s health.

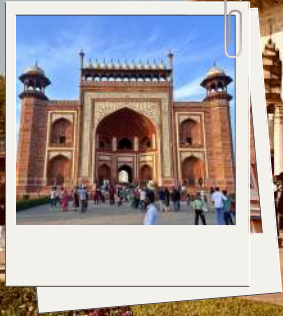
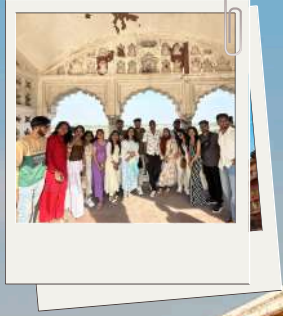
## “EMPOWERING WOMEN THROUGH LAW: AWARENESS TODAY, SAFETY TOMORROW.”

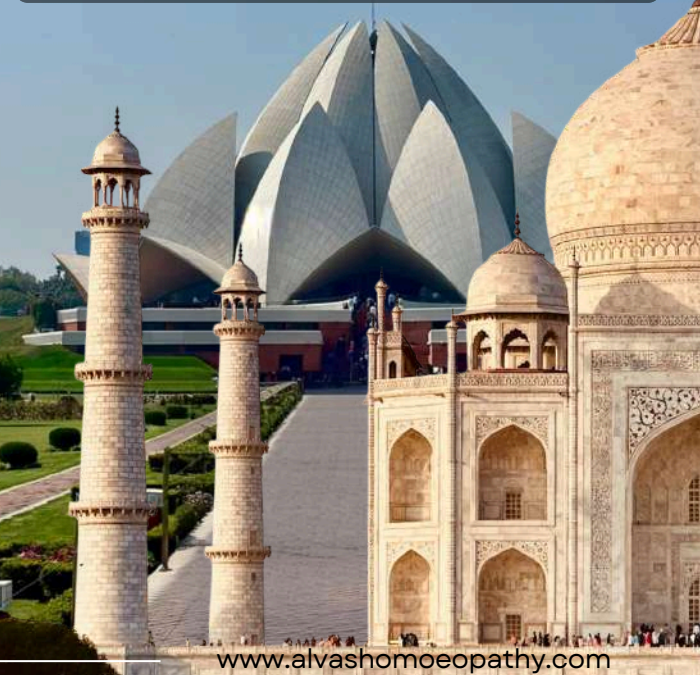
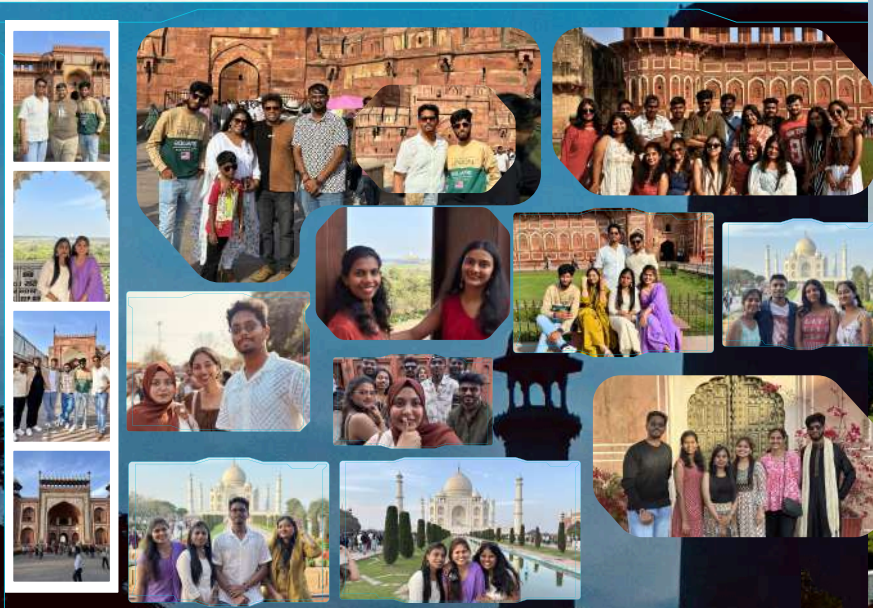
