


#### Dr. Gayathri Presents Thesis at CCRH

The first event was an oath-taking ceremony held in the college seminar hall, where students pledged their commitment to the cause. The oath was led by Dr. Sudhamathi, reinforcing the importance of active participation in TB eradication.





Additionally, an awareness camp was conducted under the same program public educate the about tuberculosis, its impact on health, and preventive measures. The camp emphasized the significance of early proper medication diagnosis, adherence, and lifestyle changes to control and eliminate encouraging the community to join hands in the fight against this infectious disease.
