Session 1: Revolutionizing Animal Healing

Topic: **Managing Difficult Cases in Veterinary with Homoeopathy**


The day began with a captivating presentation by Dr. Manohar Upadhy, whose extensive clinical expertise illuminated the lesser-explored field of veterinary homoeopathy. Through real-life case studies — from Downer Cow Syndrome to Viper Bite Envenomation — he demonstrated how individualized, symptom-based prescriptions can achieve recovery even where conventional medicine reaches its limits.

He further emphasized the role of constitutional prescription, Bach Flower Remedies, and Rescue Remedy in emergencies, bridging compassion and science. The audience left deeply inspired by his message that “healing knows no species; it is universal.”

Sessions 2 & 3: Bridging Beauty and Beyond

In his first session, Dr. Mansoor Ali redefined the perception of Homoeopathy within Cosmeto-Dermatology, introducing the concept of nano-homoeopathy for conditions such as Alopecia Totalis, Atopic Dermatitis, Lichen Planus, PCOD-related hair fall, and Warts. He integrated diagnostic imagery with repertorial rubrics, showcasing the profound role of individualized prescriptions in restoring both health and confidence.

In his second address, Dr. Mansoor shifted focus toward career guidance, enlightening students about avenues in academics, research, digital entrepreneurship, and international practice. His words served as both inspiration and roadmap for young homoeopaths ready to step into the global arena.
